



COMPETITIVE PLAYER AND PARENT CONTRACT

Congratulations on being selected to join Seminole Shooting Stars (SSS) for the 2011-2012 Seasonal Year! Your skills and hard work have earned you a spot to compete with the elite soccer clubs in the Tampa Bay area. Our coaches and Board of Directors hope that this will be an enjoyable year for you and your family. As part of the registration process, we want to insure that you are fully aware and understand the commitments SSS makes to you, and what our expectations and obligations from you as a result of you accepting the position offered to you. Please initial the points below acknowledging your understanding of the mutual expectations between you and SSS, then sign and date below.

- Although it is our intent to honor the commitment to play with SSS for the entire seasonal year, we understand that accepting the position offered and completing the registration documents obligates us to pay the full registration fees of \$500 regardless of whether we later decide to leave SSS prior to the end of the seasonal year. Fees include registration, uniforms, personal trainers, insurance, referee fees, club overhead expenses, and the league tournament (Region C or State Cup).

- We agree to make full payment on acceptance to the team or all installments toward fulfilling our financial obligation before the first regular season game in the incremental payment structure below or player is not allowed to play, unless we apply to the BOD for and receive written approval for a modified payment structure:

- We understand that we are required to perform 10 hours of volunteer work in support of the SSS club activities. These activities may include, but not be limited to concession stand duty, support during registration or picture days, uniform try-ons, picking up trash during your team's practice, lining fields, field clean up day, field marshall, SSS tournament development, club magazine, stuffing envelopes for mailouts, etc.

- We understand that SSS will provide training and coaching, opportunities to participate in league, tournament and cup games; and a uniform and equipment package consisting of two jerseys, one pair shorts, two pair of socks and an equipment bag for all new players. Additional uniforms/equipment may be purchased separately and are not included in the player fees.

- There may be a monthly coaches fee if the team agrees to hire a paid coach through SSS. It is the responsibility of the team parents to cover the coach's fees. We understand that we have the option of directly paying the coaches fees, obtaining sponsorship, or fundraising to pay for said fee. The amount of \$ ____--_ will be applied to each team member (if applicable).

- We understand that since this is a premier competitive environment, there is NO guarantee of minimum playing time. We also understand and agree to abide by the SSS policy of not allowing players to guest play with other teams or members of other teams to guest play with SSS teams, except with the express written approval of the Director of Coaching that will be accompanied by an authorized "FYSA Guest Player" form. These exceptions will only be granted if all player's fees and financial obligations have been fulfilled, and will generally be limited to opportunities that the player would not otherwise be able to participate in, or in unusual circumstances.

- Should the player wish to be released (other than for season ending injury or a move out of state) or to transfer to another club prior to the end of the seasonal year, the player/parents will be required to fulfill all financial obligations noted above with an additional \$300 fee before the Change of Status is processed.

- We understand that failure to fulfill our financial obligations to SSS may result in the player being placed "Not in Good Standing" with SSS and FYSA, which will result in the player's playing privileges being suspended until the obligations are fulfilled. This will also impact the player's ability to register with SSS or any other affiliate next year.

- We have received and read the FYSA Code of Ethics as printed below, and agree to abide by the requirements. We will act in a manner of respect at all practices, games, travel, etc., and serve as role models to others to maintain the integrity of ourselves, our team, and all of SSS. Players will conduct themselves in accordance with SSS, FYSA, USYSA, USSF, US Soccer Club and FIFA rules at all times, or will be subject to disciplinary action.

FYSA CODE OF ETHICS

PLAYERS:

- I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials and parents at all times.
- I will always remember that soccer is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol: and expect everyone to refrain from their use at all soccer training and games.
- I will do the best I can each day, remembering that all players have talents and weaknesses the same as I do.
- I will treat my coaches, other players and coaches, game officials, other administrators, and fans with respect at all times; regardless of race, sex, creed or abilities and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I will concentrate on playing soccer, always giving my best effort.
- I will play by the rules at all times.
- I will at all times control my temper, resisting the temptation to retaliate.
- My conduct during competition towards play of the game and all officials shall be in accordance with appropriate behavior, and in accordance with FIFA'S Laws of The Game, and in adherence to FYSA rules.
- While traveling, I will conduct myself so as to be a credit to myself, and my team.
- A player cannot be cut from a team after he/she is registered to that team, unless he/she has exhibited conduct requiring dismissal, without prior consent from the BOD. If requested by the player and/or parent, a hearing must be held for any involuntary player release.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during or after any game or at any time at the field and/or game complex.

PARENTS/SPECTATORS:

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, game officials, and administrators at all times.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of all players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will support the coaches, officials, and administrators working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will remember that the game is for the players, not for the adults.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, game officials, administrators, and fans with respect.
- I will always be positive.
- I will always allow the coach to be the only coach, by refraining from coaching from the sidelines.
- I will not enter into arguments with the other team's parents, players, or coaches.

- I will not enter the field of play for any reason during the game.
- I will not criticize game officials.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during, after the game or at any other time at the field and/or game complex.

Failure to comply may result in the suspension of your privilege to participate in FYSA sanctioned events, for the following periods:

1st Offense: Suspension for a minimum thirty (30) days to a maximum of (5) years.

2nd offense: Suspension for a minimum of one (1) year to a maximum of ten (10) years.

3rd offense: Suspension for a minimum of five (5) years to a maximum of fifty (50) years.

FYSA ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF REGISTRATION

FYSA RECOMMENDS THAT PLAYERS NOT REGISTER TO A TEAM WHOSE AGE GROUP EXCEEDS THE PLAYERS NORMAL AGE.

INSURANCE NOTICE: All injuries must be reported within 90 days of the date of the injury. Benefits satisfied.

INFORMED CONSENT: I, the parent/guardian of the registrant, agree that we will abide by the rules of SSS, the state association (FYSA) and all its affiliated organizations. My/our child wishes to participate in soccer during the season of this registration. I/we realize risks are involved in my/our child's participation. I/we understand that the risk to my/our child includes full range of injuries from minor to severe, and the result could be death, paralysis, or other serious, permanent disability. I/we accept this risk as a condition of my/our child's participation.
